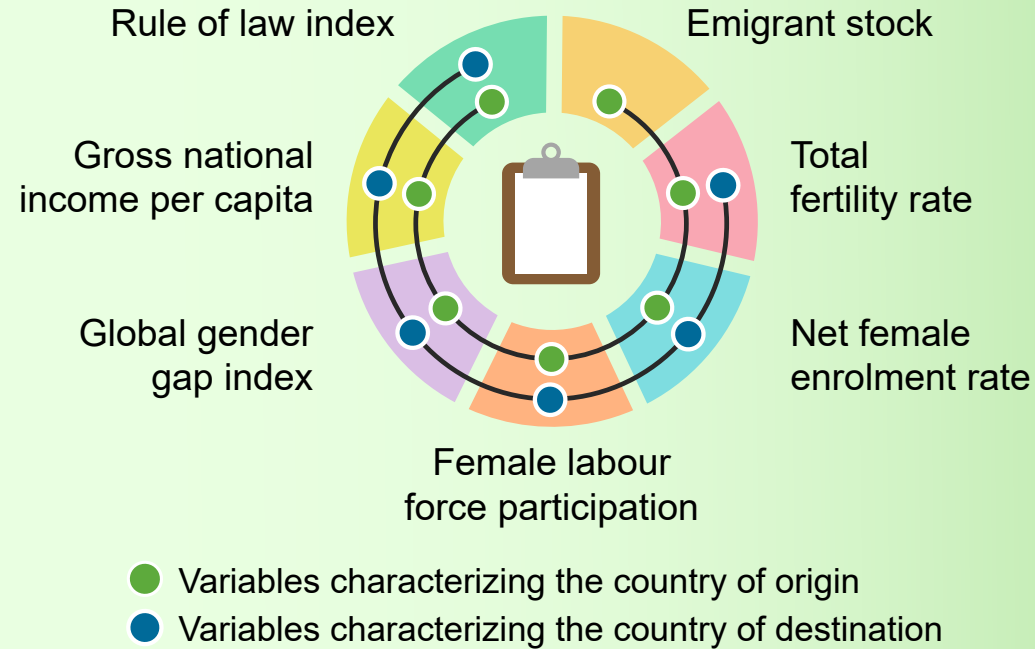


# Can International Migration Drive the Onset of a New Demographic Era Characterized by a Global Decline in Fertility?



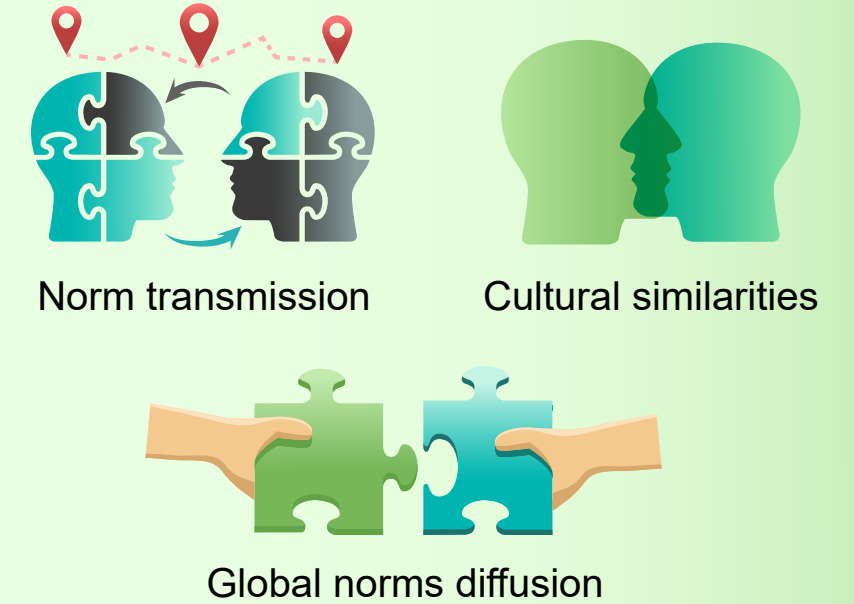
## Assessment of national level variables (N = 13)
